Place your burdens, struggles, and weaknesses in to the Hands of the Lord Almighty

- God is always there to comfort and hear the deepest concerns of our hearts.
- 1 Peter 5:7- "Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you."

Advance God's Mission

- Lord wants to use us during this season to share Hope, Love, Peace, and Joy.
- Matthew 28:17-20- "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."


