
sanctuary for a strong presence of the Holy Spirit to fill and touch the lives of all gathered for worship on Easter Sunday.



Dear Church Family and Friends of EUMC,

Greetings in the wonderful and mighty name of Jesus Christ, Easter reminds me of the LIVING HOPE we have through the resurrection of Jesus Christ. No matter what situations we may be facing in our lives, there is Hope. The hymn, 'Because He Lives, clearly describes the message of Easter "Because He lives I can face tomorrow, because He lives all fear is gone; because I know He holds the future, and life is worth the living just because he lives."

As we prepare our hearts to experience the resurrection power of Jesus Christ in our lives, I wanted to share with you about the Holy Week Services. We will have Maundy Thursday service with Holy Communion at 7pm- April 18, Good Friday Service at 7pm-April 19, Hour of Prayer on Saturday at 11am-April 20, Easter sunrise service at 7am and worship service at 10:30am- April 21. We are also holding our annual Easter Egg Hunt for children from 1-3p.m. on Saturday, April 13. We would love for you to join us.

It is also our custom to celebrate with a special Easter offering every year, and we hope you will consider making a special gift for this as well. This year's offering will be given to Homeward Bound Shelter in Covington, Kentucky. Homeward Bound Shelter (Brighton Center) is the only 24-hour emergency shelter that provides a safe environment and short-term services for runaway, homeless, abused, neglected, and dependent youth ages 11-17 in Northern Kentucky. According to the Homeward Bound Shelter website in the year 2018; 370 homeless and runaway youth received crisis services and 84 were served residentially; 286 youth received crisis intervention services through hot line or accessing shelter for non-residential services; 94% of runaway and homeless youth received exit counseling to ensure safe living arrangements; 93% of youth admitted to shelter care remained in their home school. Your support and prayers will make a huge difference in the lives of youth impacted through the Homeward Bound Shelter. Kate Arthur the community and youth service director of the shelter will be sharing with us for few minutes during worship service this Sunday, March 31st.

May the Lord continue to bless you for you faithfulness and generosity in supporting the ministries of Erlanger United Methodist Church for the advancement of the Kingdom of God locally and globally. We thank you once again.
